RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Jelly Bean Nests

2 Cups miniature marshmallows

4 Cups Chow Mein Noodles

¼ Cup Butter

Butter a 12 cup muffin pan. Combine marshmallows and butter over medium heat in a saucepan; stir until the butter and marshmallows have melted. Stir in the chow mein noodles. Coat well. Butter fingers and press the mixture into the bottom and sides of the prepared muffin tin. Refrigerate until firm.
